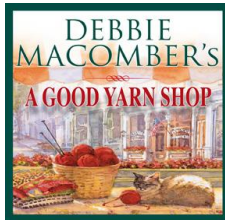

Learn everything you need to knit socks on double pointed needles. Two sessions: 1 st session is 1 hour, 2 nd session is 3 hours.

Learn to knit two socks on one long circular needle. You must be a competent knitter. (2) 2-hour sessions.

Many people say toe-up socks fit better – why not find out for yourself? This class will be offered in two sessions, each two hours long.

The more efficient way to knit! This class is especially oriented to those who already knit and “throw” their yarn and who wish to change to the “picking” method. This skill is required for fair isle knitting.

Japanese Short Row Socks	Instructor: Caryn Ackerman	\$35
Fantastic for using that self-striping sock yarn you’ve got in your stash! Learn to knit a sock using only short rows and the Japanese short row technique. This technique gives you a crazy design! You must be a sock knitter already to take this class.

Refootable Sock	Instructor: Caryn Ackerman	\$25
Learn to knit a refootable sock from the cuff down. The heel, bottom and toe of the sock are knit in such a way that they can easily be taken out later and reknit. This is a sock making technique. You will be able to convert any standard sock pattern into a refootable version. You must be a sock knitter already to take this class. Pattern provided.

Fair Isle Classes

Introduction to Fair Isle

Instructor: Sheila Joynes

Learn the basics of two handed, stranded color knitting called Fair Isle. Class will include history, techniques, and materials used in Fair Isle. Class projects are Fair Isle cowl and hat. **3 two-hour sessions for a total of 6 hours of instruction (plus ongoing support groups)**

Advanced Fair Isle

This is a Fair Isle technique class including an introduction to steeks. Students will have a choice of projects: doll mini-sweater or adult size vest in the "Hydrangea" pattern. Another project may be chosen with prior approval from the instructor. You may pick your own colors for your vest. **Note:** Fair Isle Color Theory or previous fair isle experience is required. (4) two-hour sessions and ongoing support groups.

You will learn the use of color in Fair Isle. Each student will choose colors for a hat project to make it their own design. Students will learn different techniques for motivation of color and why the rules of color in Fair Isle work. Students will swatch, design and knit their own hat. Yarn for swatching included in class fee. (3) two-hour sessions for a total of 6 hours of instruction, plus ongoing support groups.

Neck-Down Cardigan Sweater

This is an easy first sweater and/or first project after a Beginning Knitting class. Learn increases, decreases and working with double point needles. This class is given in (4) two-hour sessions.

The Diagonal Hat pattern is written by Nihon Vogue instructor Jean Wong and is a unique approach to knitting a hat. Learn provisional cast-on, slip stitches and grafting garter stitch. Pattern cost – payable at class time to instructor - \$10.

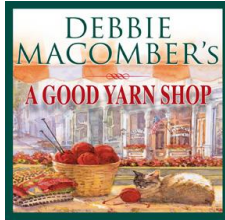
Learn how to design your own custom fit pullover or cardigan sweater (knit in the round) based on the Elizabeth Zimmerman Percentage System. Textbook required. If knitting a cardigan, students will learn how to do the steek method. Yarn choices and sweater design possibilities will be discussed in the first class. Class is held in (6) two-hour sessions for a total of 12 hours of instruction.

Pattern Drafting & Japanese Knitting Techniques

Offered in **eight 2-hour sessions**, this highly specialized class, taught by Caryn Ackerman, is like no other. During class, students will knit a round neck pullover vest or shell from scratch (no pattern) using Japanese knitting techniques. Learn the exacting Japanese method of drafting your own personalized patterns and learn how to knit to fit without following someone else's pattern. This is an amazing opportunity that you won't find everywhere else! Sessions will start when we have a firm commitment from the required number of students. More info will be available at the shop regarding dates and times. Class fee is \$200, plus a \$20 fee for the Japanese Gauge Ruler, payable to the instructor.
