# Cupcake with Icing

One skein "Cupcake" yarn by Joseph A. Geller

Size 8 needles (go up a size if you tend to knit tightly)

Finished size (approximate): 8" x 35" after blocking

This scarf is meant to be worn tucked into a coat to provide a pretty bit of lace at the neckline.

Cast on 30 stitches. Knit four rows.

Begin pattern: K2 \*yfrn, p2tog, k2; repeat from \* to end

Repeat this row until you have enough yarn left to knit four rows and bind off.

K2 = knit two stitches, one at a time

Yfrn = yarn forward and round the needle (increase)

P2tog = purl two stitches together

Note: If you choose to change the width of this scarf, you can do so easily. The number of stitches cast on **must be a multiple of 4, then add 2 more stitches**. For example, this scarf has 30 stitches:  $(4 \times 7) + 2 = 30$ .
